



Player Consent Agreement IFA Competitions

Parents and or legal guardians of minors participating in any Independent Football Australia Limited (“**IFA**”) sanctioned Competition must agree to the following terms and conditions, some of which limit their rights that exist at law.

The Academy is responsible and undertakes that it has received consent agreements from all players’ parents and or legal guardians who compete in any IFA sanctioned competition. In the event it fails to, the academy bears responsibility and holds IFA harmless for any damage, injury (reputational or otherwise) liability, costs and expenses or loss that it may incur in respect of same.

1. I/we consent to the participant of football by a minor to which I/we am the legal parent and or guardian, where such competition is organised by IFA.
2. I/we agree to grant IFA (and third parties engaged by IFA to promote an IFA sanctioned competition) a worldwide, royalty-free, fully paid-up license to use my and the player’s photographic, video, or digital likeness solely for promotional and/or commercial purposes.
3. IFA shall have no liability for any injury, damage, cost, expense or loss incurred as a result of participation in a competition sanctioned by IFA. I/we hold IFA harmless for any such liability. I/we accept there is a risk for the minor in which I/we am legally responsible to be exposed from participation risk. This may include but is not limited to falls, contact with other players, the effects of weather including heat and or humidity, and the conditions of the grounds and facilities, all risks being understood and appreciated by me/us.
4. I/we will not hold IFA, its directors, officers, agents, employees or anyone acting on its behalf responsible or liable for injury occurring in the course of participation.
5. I/we consent to IFA arranging any necessary medical emergency care that may become reasonably necessary for the player in the course of participation.
6. Having read and understood the aforementioned, I/we hereby waive and release IFA and its directors, officers, agents, contractors, employees, instructors, trainers, referees, volunteers, members, representatives and all affiliated and related companies from all claims and liabilities of any kind arising out of the player’s involvement whilst registered as a player participating in any and all IFA sanctioned competition anywhere in the World.
7. As parent guardian, I/we and the player are responsible for understanding the rules of play and the codes of conduct. We agree to follow the reasonable directions of academy directors, their coaches and staff, referees and IFA officials. I/we acknowledge that failing same I/we or the player may be expelled immediately and from future competitions.
8. For reasons of expulsion by IFA or the player’s academy, force majeure or other unforeseen events, no refunds will be made. I/we agree to indemnify and hold IFA harmless from and against any loss, cost, expense, injury or damage as a result of same.
9. This agreement is governed by the laws of New South Wales law without regard to conflict of laws principles.
